The following ACTIONS were agreed.

1) Construction Issues

- a) Construction Signs
 - The Matthewsgreen sign has not yet been taken down- BOVIS
- b) Wheel Cleaning
 - Neighbourhood watch is being re-formed and this could also help with the security issue- RESIDENTS
 - · Road sweeping will not take place during rush hour- BOVIS
 - Sweeping of Matthewsgreen road should be finished by 16th of May- BOVIS
- c) Contractor Parking / Deliveries
 - Bovis will co-ordinate with residents group over issues that have been received-BOVIS
 - The term Emmbrook Walk will be used instead of Emmbrook Corridor-BOVIS/CRATUS/SAVILLS
 - Residents are advised to take the registration numbers of contractor vehicles which are parked incorrectly and inform Bovis- RESIDENTS
 - Bovis will continue to advise their contactors and sub-contractors of the guidelines and take action when they have been breached- BOVIS
- d) Other Construction Issues
 - Bovis will get information to the residents regarding the SANG regarding which construction plans deal with the site and how will they be secured? -BOVIS
 - Bovis will produce a document specifically for those areas and Cratus will distribute-BOVIS/CRATUS
 - Bovis will close Toutley Road access as soon as feasible or practical -BOVIS
 - Councillors will try and get speed limit reduced to 30 MPH- COUNCILLORS
 - Flooding- run off will be captured and re-routed back to stream. The Balancing Pond is under construction now- BOVIS

 Bovis will make sure to make residents aware of when hedgerows on Matthewsgreen Road are being replaced and Cratus will distribute- BOVIS/CRATUS

2) Communication

- It was agreed that a new website will be up and running as soon as possible and that
 once it's been done Cratus will deliver a leaflet to the community highlighting the new
 contact details- CRATUS COMMUNICATIONS
- Leaflet will include emergency out of hours number- CRATUS COMMUNICATIONS
- Cratus will have weekly phone calls with Bovis to make sure they are up to date-CRATUS
- · Cratus will be the first point of contact for the residents-CRATUS
- Cratus will make sure both good and bad news is sent out speedily through our means of information and residents websites-CRATUS
- Cratus will organise the opening of the show homes-CRATUS

3) Planning / Timeframes / NDR / Construction Access

a) NDR / Construction Access

- Developers separate to Bovis will be submitting applications later in 2016/early 2017 and Bovis and Cratus will draw attention to the applications- BOVIS/CRATUS
- Cllr Singleton will have an officer joining the next meeting to discuss construction access-COUNCILLORS
- Bovis will work out parking for the show homes-BOVIS
- Bovis and Savills explained the recent changes which have been made and advised that they are down to changes in regulation and will not materially affect the development.

b) SANGs

- Contractor has been appointed and the sign will be installed-BOVIS
- More information distributed regarding the future work- CRATUS

c) Primary School / Other

- Joel Park will send the detailed response they have received to the Emmbrook Residents Association- RESIDENTS
- It was confirmed that the school will be built.

d) Phase 1 & General

- Bovis has been chasing up officer regarding the design of the storey block of flats but have had no response. Cllr Singleton will chase up- COUNCILLORS
- Savills will confirm timeframes and send to Cratus to update- CRATUS

4) Feedback

- The Joel Park resident's association gave credit to Bovis for the way their staff have interacted with the local community, they have been friendly and engaging,
- Temp lights will be installed to provide lighting to the PROW boundary-BOVIS
