Works dates

We will try to keep you updated on works but please bear in mind that dates may change due to weather and other outside influences. Again, we will make every effort to tell you when this happens.

Works to complete the Twyford Road roundabout will commence imminently, this is planned to take approximately one week if no unexpected disruptions arise.

The completion of the Toutley Road / Matthewsgreen Road junction and the installation of the zebra crossing on Toutley Road will also take place in January with an expected programme of two weeks. Following this, and depending on approval from the Wokingham Borough Council Street Works team, the installation of another zebra crossing on Matthews Green Road outside Emmbrook School will commence.

All road surfacing is very much weather dependent and should temperatures drop near freezing, resurfacing maybe delayed but we continue to expect the Northern Distributor Road to be completed in February. More information on this will be provided in next month's edition of the newsletter.
