Works updates

Bovis Homes intend to submit planning applications for the new District Centre and the Care Home by Summer 2018, with approval expected in Autumn 2018. The works are expected to last for eighteen months.


Unfortunately planned works for the Emmbrook School and Toutley Road crossings have been delayed. We are now expecting these works to be carried out during the Easter holidays, as this will enable the work to be completed in the school break. We apologise for this delay, any questions please do get in touch.

Works to complete the Northern Distributor road have experienced some unavoidable delays, and as a result the completion date is now likely to be mid to late March. Further updates will be provided in the coming month's newsletter.

Following some recent enquiries from residents, please be advised that the road surface on the Toutley Road, Emmbrook Road junction is a temporary surface.

In order to alleviate the ongoing flooding issues near to the railway bridge, drainage works along the Emmbrook road will commence from the 26th March, for a period of approximately four weeks. To enable Wokingham Borough Council's highways contractor, Balfour Beatty, to conduct these works safely, the road will need to be closed between the Railway Bridge and Reading Road and a diversion route will be sign posted (Reading Road, Old Forest Road, Lowther Road or this route in reverse). During this time the road will remain open to pedestrians, residents will still be able to access their properties and visitors will be able to access the public house, The Rifle Volunteer.
