Works Updates

Northern Distributor Road

The Northern Distributor Road is expected to open early Summer 2018, with the team currently carrying out final snagging works. This is a necessary part of the inspection and road opening process, agreed in conjunction with Wokingham Borough Council. We apologise for the delays and thank you for your continuing patience

Build updates

Phase 1 has now been substantially completed, and the landscaping teams have been in over the last few weeks planting up the central spine and other areas. Bovis Homes have just a couple more homes to sell on phase 1 but our sales centre remains open 5 days a week, Thursday to Monday between 10am to 5pm, if you would like to come in and have a look or just say hello. Phase 2 is also well underway and is being built on behalf of Thames Valley Housing Association who, alongside the Social Rented units, will also be providing a large number of Shared Ownership Homes through their "So Resi" brand. This will provide people the chance to own their own home, who otherwise would not be able to afford prices locally. We also hear Linden are progressing well on their Phases.

Following the grant of planning permission for the new primary school on Matthewsgreen Farm, Bovis Homes have agreed a handover date with the Council for late Summer. This means that the school site will be ready for Wokingham Borough Council and for their contractors to start on site in Autumn.

The highways applications to allow Bovis to undertake the works to the junction of Toutely / Matthewsgreen Road and also to install the crossings on Toutely Road were submitted to the Council and we are expecting to undertake the works between the 4th and 15th June.

The application to undertake to install the Emmbrook Road crossing has also been submitted to the Council and we are expecting to be provided with dates for the works soon. Please be advised that the works to install the Emmbrook Road crossing will need to be completed within the Summer Holidays due to the close proximity of the school.

The Matthewsgreen suitable alternative natural greenspace (SANG) has already been handed over to Wokingham Borough Council, who will continue to manage it as an excellent resource for recreation for both existing and future residents. Bovis Homes are also pleased to share with you the newly installed information sign on the Matthewsgreen SANG, located near the footbridge over the Emm Brook.
