## Advance Notification of upcoming works along sections of A329 Reading Road

We would like to take this opportunity to notify you of some upcoming works near you.

Two sets of temporary traffic lights, two-way and four-way, are planned to be in operation along sections of A329 Reading Road from Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> June for three days. This is to allow us to carry out ground investigation works, also known as trial holes, at four locations marked as red boxes on the plan below.

These works, which are scheduled to take place during off-peak hours (09:30 – 15:30), will allow us to break out sections of the northbound carriageway using vacuum excavation as well as complete resurfacing works.

Daily public safety will remain a priority, as will the access to the Emergency Services. Additionally, access for local residents will remain open at all times.

Due to the nature of the works, noise levels may be higher than normal which we appreciate may be an inconvenience. We will obviously be doing everything practical to keep any intrusion to a minimum and mitigate the impact as far as possible.









These works are part of the wider North Wokingham Distributor Road scheme.

Once completed this section of the NWDR will reduce traffic through the town centre, provide access to new housing developments and minimise the impact of increased traffic on existing roads.

We kindly ask you to bear with us while we carry out these necessary works and apologise in advance for any inconvenience this may cause. Should you have any queries or concerns please contact the Balfour Beatty helpdesk on 0800 121 4444.
