

ADVANCE NOTIFICATION OF UPCOMING RE-OPENING OF OLD FOREST ROAD & FULL ROAD CLOSURE OF TOUTLEY ROAD

We would like to take this opportunity to notify you of the opening of Old Forest Road to road traffic on 06th April 2021. The reopening of Old Forest Road will allow Toutley Road to be closed from 6th April until November 2021 and enable the next phase of the NWDR project works to commence.

The closure points are detailed on the location plan below:



HGV Road Diversion route

Disruption to this section of the road network, in this case, is inevitable and we kindly ask you to familiarise yourself with the road diversion route map, shown directly below, so that you can notify friends, neighbours, relatives and anyone that would need to know about this. This diversion route has been assessed by the relevant authorities and approved by Wokingham Borough Council. It has taken into consideration the strong potential of increased traffic on residential roads, particularly in Toutley Road. The diversion route has been designed to divert traffic through to Aroads and avoid traffic passing near schools and normally busier sections of the route where possible.



Pedestrian Diversion route

A separate pedestrian route map has also been prepared and approved by the local authority. This has taken into consideration the safest route possible for pedestrians, including cyclists and dog-walkers and we strongly advise that you follow this route. Please see location plan below.

Access into new Country Park

The new Country Park will remain open throughout the period of our works. Access (which is wheelchair-friendly) into the Park will be from Old Forest Road opposite the Emmbrook bridges. All other access will be closed for the period of our works. Please see location plan below showing the Park open and closed access points.
